

FROM THE ROMAN BRIDGE TO THE CELTIC CLIFFS:

- * Start: from Piazza 28 Aprile - Saint-Vincent
- * Minimum altitude 570mt, maximum altitude 680 mt
- * Length: 2h for a complete walk
- * Specific signage along the way
- * Recommended period: during the winter season is better to go in the morning. During the springtime you can see beautiful flowers.

From Piazza Funicolare surrounded by beautiful liberty villas, in 10 min you can reach the Roman Bridge dating back to the 25 b.C. and built along the 'Strada delle Gallie'. On the right you will find a signal leading to 'Cillian': passing across a vineyard you will reach a chestnuts wood. In front of the little village of Chadel, along the paved road to Feilley, you will find a narrow pathway.

Pretty soon you will see several wooden blocks indicating stunning observation points. The wooden blocks also indicate ancient rocks carvings, soap and titanium stones. Colorful walls made of granite rocks carried by the ancient glacier and then left there after the glacier erosion, are still visible. Big reddish stones smoothed by the glacial erosion smell pleasingly of thyme. From the top (1 hour), which has a wonderful stone cross, you can enjoy a stunning view over four castles and the ancient landslide, which in the past blocked the natural river flow creating a lake up to the city of Aosta.



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
